Question1: Emphasize assistance to small farmers for conservation efforts, and for using sustainable methods.

Question2: Encourage organic farming practices.

Encourage sustainable farming practices.

Provide startup money and/or loans for farmers who want to switch from conventional agriculture to organic agric.

Question3: Perhaps a top limit on how much money a farm or individual can receive in form of agricultural department benefits, so that more money would be available for the smaller operations.

Question4: Reward actual conservation practices; also provide incentives for sustainable practices and for organic agriculture.
