Question3: The Nature Conservancy, Ducks Unlimited, Pheasants Unlimited and many other nonprofit groups receive millions of dollars from the conservation parts of the farm bill. They are taking this money directly from funds that are supposed to go to farmers. They pay no Federal or State taxes on this income. Farmers that receive these payments pay from 30 to 45% taxes and social security back to the government. There are also many "big city" boys that buy good pasture land or borderline farm land for big prices and work the farm program to pay for it. Farmers who try to purchase this for farm or livestock use are unable to get good enough returns from farming to pay for it.

Only bonifide farmers should get these funds. If non profits continue to have access to this money they should be taxed an amount Of 45% or so and this deducted from their check.
