Question4: By recognizing and promoting the benefits that forest canopy cover provides. To wit, one acre of healthy forest is 10-15x more effective than grass at reducing stormwater runoff. Water quality increases and in some cases localized flooding may be reduced. In addition, urban trees are valued for their air quality benefits, via interception of particulates and through the moderation of air temperatures leading to reduced ozone production in summertime. Farm policies need to incorporate canopy cover that is as valuable to suburban and urban residents as to rural residents.
