Question1: A concentraton of market power in agri-business makes it difficult for small and medium sized farmers to stay in farming and hard for younger people to get into farming. Future policy needs to address this unintended consequence by supportina a fair competition title in the next farm bill.

Question2: WTO requires redluction in ag subsidies- but should not comes at espense of driving farmers and ranchers off the land. By reducing farm comodity payments to reasonable levels, the money saved should be transferred into conservation "green" payments like the Conservation Security Program .

Question3: Enactt the Grassley-Dorgan payment limitations bill. Restore effictive payment limitations to Environmental Quality Incentives Program and do not allow EQIP to expand concentrated livestock production.

Question4: The Conservation Security Program and the Conservaton Reserve or Wetland reserve programs are keys !

Question5: Provide financial support for rural entrepreneurial and small business development. Also support Value-Added Producer Grants program by reducing current commodity payments.

Question6: Stimulate new markets thru - Rural Business Enterprise Grants, Value- Added Producer Grants, and the National Research Initiative for Future Agriculture and Food Systems. Demonstrate a commitment to organic research and outreach. Funding for new Farmers Market Promotion Program and farm-to-Cafeteria programs.
