Question4: Farm policy should support state efforts to protect and restore streams on a watershed scale instead of a general shot gun approach to environmental improvements. Programs should be delivered in priority watersheds and targeted to operations that are causing a problem. Practices should be required to address all the environmental issues on the farm.
