EFFECTIVE DATE: August 1, 2004. Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS) must approve all fees for official service and OAs will assess only those fees appearing on their current approved fee schedule.

REGULAR HOURS: 7:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. Monday through Friday, except holidays. (1)

REGULAR, STANDBY, AND TRAVEL TIME RATE: \$17.40 per hour in half-hour increments. Travel time will apply to services performed outside Memphis city limits.

OVERTIME AND HOLIDAY HOURLY RATE: \$26.10 per hour for Saturday, Sunday, Holidays, and other than regular weekly hours. Holidays include New Years Day, Presidents' Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. There will be a four hour minimum for call in.

MILEAGE: The IRS standard mileage rate will be assessed for all services performed outside Memphis city limits. All charges for mileage will be prorated where possible. Any change to the mileage rate is effective when the IRS changes their standard mileage rate.

PER DIEM FEES: Actual motel cost (maximum \$70) plus \$30 expenses when required to stay overnight.

SERVICE CHARGES: Assessed on bills more than 60 days overdue, 1.5% per month.

OFFICIAL SERVICE CHARGES: Charges includes FGIS user fees unless otherwise noted.
