

# GUIDE FOR NAVIGATING THE NASS WEB SITE

Below are step-by-step instructions for locating some survey and census data from the NASS Web site [www.usda.gov/nass/](http://www.usda.gov/nass/)

## Survey—Crop Production Reports [ Example: Wheat Production Report ]

At the NASS Web site, click on “Publications,” then “Reports by Commodity.” Scroll down, and click on report name [wheat ], click on “Look Up Report(s),” click on “Crop Production,” click on Reports by year [ 2002 ], then click on PDF to view and/or print the report.

## Census—Complete Volume 1 publication [ U.S., state, and county level data ]

At the NASS Web site, click on “Census of Agriculture,” then “Complete Volume” (PDF). Select and click on your state. [ note: 1997 Census of Agriculture Volume 1: Chapter 1 is for state-level data, and Chapter 2 is for county-level data.]. Scroll down/up, and click on the PDF adjacent to the table desired.

## Census—County Highlights [ Highlights comparing 1997 to 1992 data ]

At the NASS Web site, click on “Census of Agriculture,” then “Highlights.” Select and click on your state (from the map or the state listing below the map), then click on your county.

## Census—US Agricultural Maps [ Multi-color pattern and dot maps ]

At the NASS Web site, click on “Census of Agriculture,” then “Agricultural Atlas.” Click on “Go to Maps Index Page.” Scroll down until you get to your map choice, then click on the map title desired.

## Census—Ranking of States and Counties [ 20 leading states and 100 leading-counties ]

At the NASS Web site, click on “Census of Agriculture.” Under the green “Ranking” button, click on “States & Counties.” Click on the third button down, “Ranking of State and County Tables.” Click on the table desired.
