

Pheasants Forever is dedicated to the conservation of pheasants, quail, and other wildlife through habitat improvements, public awareness, education, and land management policies and programs.






2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities



Biofuels and Renewable Energy -

- Use the 2007 Farm Bill as an opportunity to promote the next generation of biofuels and renewable energy
- Be consistent with fish, wildlife, soil, nutrient management and water conservation goals



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

“Sodsaver” or Non-cropland Conversion –



- This is land that does not meet the definition of cropland
- Land converted from non cropland status to cropland should be made ineligible for any federal benefit




2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) –



- Reauthorize the USDA's most successful conservation program
- Ensure the competitive viability of the program
- Expand CRP acreage to 45 million acres



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Wetlands Reserve Program (WRP) -

- Increase to 300,000 acres per year



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Grasslands Reserve Program (GRP) -


- Increase GRP to 2 million acres per year



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Wildlife Habitat Incentives Program (WHIP) -


- Increase the WHIP funding from \$100 million to \$300 million over the course of the 2007 Farm Bill



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Access –

- Include a provision based upon “Open Fields” legislation
- Provide \$20 million per year in grants to fund state-managed voluntary access programs



2007 Farm Bill Conservation Priorities

Conservation Security Program (CSP) –

- Reauthorize CSP and ensure it provides increased measurable and consistent benefits for fish and wildlife conservation
- Require fish and wildlife habitat improvement components for all program tiers
- Ensure CSP to enhance other USDA conservation programs and not replace or reduce their funding.
