Pam Johnson, of Floyd, Iowa, is the past President of the National Corn Growers Association (NCGA). She is the first woman to hold that office. A sixth generation farmer, Johnson raises corn and soybeans with her husband, two sons and their young families. They also manage a seed business and are member investors in ethanol and biodiesel production plants.

Pam serves as the Second Vice President of Maizall, the international maize alliance of corn grower associations from Argentina, Brazil, the National Corn Growers Association of the U.S. and the U.S. Grains Council. On the national level, she serves as a board member of the Foundation for Food and Agriculture Research (FFAR) and the National Coalition for Food and Agriculture Research (NC-FAR). Formerly, Johnson was Chair of the Iowa Corn Promotion Board, Chair of the NCGA Research and Business Development Action Team and a member of the U.S. Grains Council Biotech and Trade Policy Action Teams.
