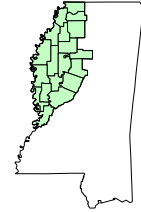

WEATHER AND CLIMATE INFORMATION

Low pressure has brought precipitation back to the region for today and some areas tomorrow, but high pressure is expected over the weekend to bring drier, but possibly cooler, conditions. The heaviest rains today and tonight are expected towards the south and southeast parts of the state, but the southern Delta zones may experience moderate rainfall compared to areas north. Approximately 1 to 2 inches of rainfall is forecast for central to southern Delta zones, with possibly lighter amounts further north of less than an inch. There are expected to be locally-heavier areas of rainfall of 2 to 4 inches. The recent rains has placed several counties under flood warnings since yesterday, with flash flood watches being dispersed as needed. Here are a few associated flood warnings:

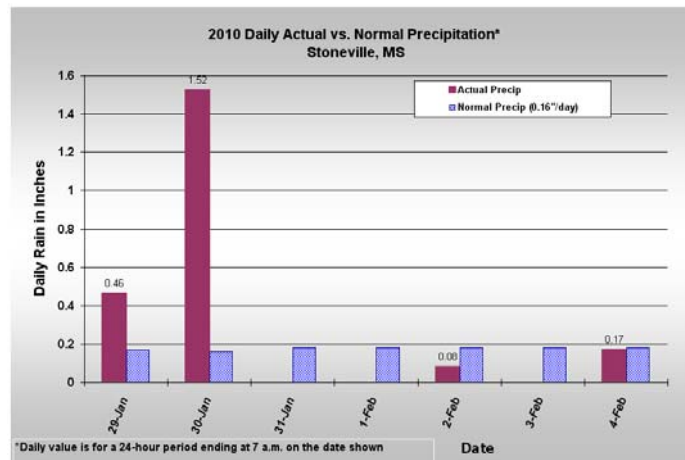
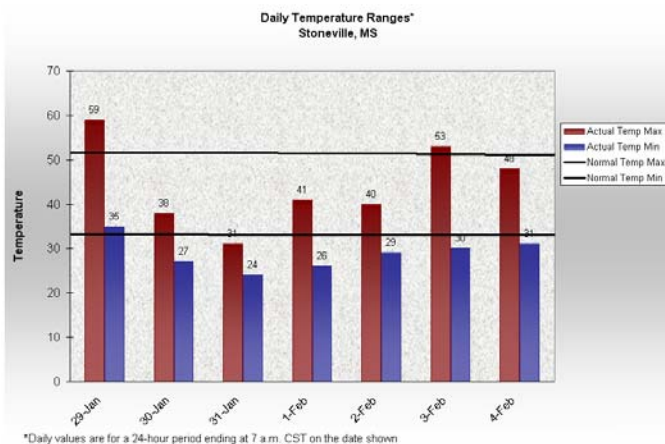

Next week may experience a similar trend, as the NWS 6- to 10-day outlook calls for below-average temperatures, with above-average rain chances towards the southern Delta between the 9th to 13th of February.



Temperatures lowered as rain episodes increased, and fluctuated near-normal during short dry spells. Last week's rains of 2.23 inches has added to the current yearly rainfall now at 8.34 inches; however, only .25 inches occurred since February 1 (The NCDC 30-yr Feb normal is 4.46 inches).
