#### **Informal Consultations**

### **Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC)**

The Codex Secretariat has distributed a letter from the CAC Chairperson and Vice-Chairpersons (CVCs) regarding the approach for informal consultations on the proposed draft Maximum Residue Levels (MRLs) for zilpaterol hydrochloride. The 44<sup>th</sup> Session of the CAC (CAC44) tasked the CVCs "to undertake informal consultations with all relevant parties to encourage and enable sustained effort to build consensus in advance of CAC45," scheduled for November 2022. The CVCs plan an initial round of consultations through April 2022, with the aim to facilitate the development of positions by Members that might move towards consensus. They will then submit a report in advance of the 83<sup>rd</sup> Session of the Executive Committee (CCEXEC83) (November 2022) to inform the CCEXEC's further monitoring and critical review.
