Codex Committee on Nutrition and Foods for Special Dietary Use (CCNFSDU)

Infant Formula Standard: CCNFSDU invites Members and Observers to join an EWG, chaired by the United States of America, working in English, to work on the Optional Ingredients in the Infant Formula Standard

for the 44th Session of CCNFSDU. The specific terms of reference are to:

- review the use of fructans, beta-carotene, lycopene in the context of optional ingredients in the Standard for Infant Formula and Formulas for Special Medical Purposes Intended for Infants (CXS 72-1981);
- ii. develop recommendations to CCNFSDU44 regarding the safety and suitability of these ingredients as optional ingredients in CXS 72-1981; and
- iii. submit a report for discussion at CCNFSDU44.
