



Instructions for Growing Golden Sweet Peas

1. Place the cup in a sunny location.
2. Place the cup on a plate or shallow bowl if you are keeping it inside.
3. Check if the soil is moist (not soaking wet) every day. If needed, add a little water, but don't add too much or the plant will drown.
4. Keep the plant in the cup until it sprouts and grows approximately 6 inches high (2-3 weeks).
5. Once your plant is 6 inches high, plant the entire cup (paper and all) into the ground or a large pot of soil.
6. Push a long stick into the soil near the plant; the peas will use the stick to grow tall.
7. Continue watering and watch your peas grow!
