
Five Pillars

- **Generating and retaining green jobs through recreation and natural resource restoration, conservation, and management**







Funding of Research Priorities





Forest Service Budget Shifts Focus


Total Acres of Lands Protected from Conversion Using LWCF funding

- Fully funds fire suppression at the 10-year average, and includes a contingency fund of \$282 million
- Proposes a new budget line item for Integrated Resource Restoration to focus the agency on the work of responding to the forest health crisis
- Funds the Collaborative Forest Landscape Restoration Fund at \$40 million, the full authorized level
- Provides an increase of \$50 million for a new Priority Watersheds and Job Stabilization initiative
- Includes an increase of \$31 million to support the President's commitment of fully funding the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) by 2014

1995 to 2008


