In 2000, MDY rebranded RMS and named it FileSurf; FileSurf 7.0 was reviewed, tested and certified by the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) 5015.2 Standard for electronic records management applications.

MDY raised venture capital funding in August 2002 to more rapidly expand sales and marketing functions to accelerate revenue growth.

MDY opened a UK and European sales office in January 2003.

In February 2003, FileSurf was certified by the U.S. DoD 5015.2 (Version 2) Standard; also certified with the Standard were FileSurf's integrations with iManage and Hummingbird document management applications.
