The respondents admit the jurisdictional allegations as set forth herein and specifically admit that the Secretary has jurisdiction in this matter, neither admit nor deny the remaining allegations of the complaint, waive oral hearing and further procedure, and consent and agree, for the purpose of settling this proceeding and for such purpose only, to the entry of this decision.

At all times material hereto, respondents were engaged in business as a certified organic producer, crop operation, as defined in the OFPA, and became a certified operation on January 15, 2004, pursuant to an organic certificate issued by the Oregon Tilth Certified Organic (OTCO), an accredited certification agent of the United States Department of Agriculture. On April 29, 2002, OTCO was accredited by USDA as a certifying agent under the NOP Regulations.

The respondents having admitted the jurisdictional facts and the parties having agreed to the entry of this decision, such decision will be entered.

Order

1. Respondents, their agents and employees, successors and assigns, directly or through any corporate or other device, shall not violate the OFPA and the NOP Regulations promulgated thereunder.

The provisions of this order shall become effective upon issuance of this Order.
