ORDER DISMISSING WAGE GARNISHMENT ACTION

By Order issued October 4, 2012, I suspended action in this matter for six months

pending the results of a review of a foreclosure against Petitioner's real property. By Order

issued on April 10, 2013, I directed Petitioner to provide in writing the status of the review.

On April 22, 2012, Petitioner filed a request for another extension, along with a letter

from the Independent Review Administration dated April 2, 2013. In that correspondence, it was

made clear that the foreclosure action that was taken against Petitioner would be reviewed, but

extensive additional time was necessary. Petitioner's lender was not among those required to

make cash payments consequent to a recent settlement between Lenders and the United States

Department of Justice.

Upon consideration of the totality of the evidence, I accord substantial weight to the

evidence of both parties. Accordingly, the evidence regarding the validity of the debt is in

equipoise, and the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development has not met its

burden of proving the debt by the preponderance of the evidence.

For the foregoing reasons, this action is DISMISSED with prejudice.
