AS TO RESPONDENT DALE WATTS

This proceeding was instituted under the Horse Protection Act, as amended (15 U.S.C. § 1821 et seq.)(HPA or Act), by a complaint filed by the Administrator of the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, United States Department of Agriculture (APHIS), on January 9, 2017, and amended on September 6, 2018, alleging that the respondents violated the Act.

Respondents Dale Watts admits the jurisdictional allegations in the amended complaint as to him, and specifically admits that the Secretary has jurisdiction in this matter, denies the remaining allegations, and waives oral hearing and further procedure. The parties consent and agree to the entry of this decision for the purpose of settling this proceeding as to respondent Dale Watts, and resolving any and all other alleged or potential violations of the Act by him occurring up to and including September 2, 2018. This decision is entered pursuant to the consent decision provisions of the Rules of Practice applicable to this proceeding (7 C.F.R. § 1.138).

Findings of Fact

1. Respondent Dale Watts is an individual residing in [REDACTED] and at all times mentioned herein, was a “person” and an “exhibitor,” as those terms are defined in the regulations promulgated under the Act (9 C.F.R. Parts 11 and 12).

2. On September 2, 2016, respondent Dale Watts entered a horse (Uptight José) for showing in class 174 in a horse show in Shelbyville, Tennessee.

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Conclusion of Law

Respondent Dale Watts having admitted the findings of fact set forth above, and the parties having agreed to the entry of this decision, such decision will be entered.

Order

1. Respondent Dale Watts is disqualified for four months, beginning September 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, from showing, exhibiting, or entering any horse, directly or indirectly through any agent, employee, or other device, and from judging, managing or otherwise participating in any horse show, horse exhibition, or horse sale or auction, directly or indirectly through any agent, employee, or other device.<sup>1</sup>

2. Respondent Dale Watts is assessed a civil penalty of \$550, which shall be paid by September 1, 2019, by check made payable to "USDA/APHIS," indicating that the payment is in reference to HPA Docket No. 17-0090, and sent to:

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<sup>1</sup>"Participating" means engaging in any activity beyond that of a spectator, and includes, without limitation, transporting or arranging for the transportation of horses to or from equine events, personally giving instructions to exhibitors, being present in the warm-up or inspection areas or in any area where spectators are not allowed, and financing the participation of others in equine events.

The provisions of this order shall become final and effective on April 15, 2019. This order may be executed in counterparts. Copies of this decision shall be served upon the parties.
