This proceeding was instituted under the Animal Welfare Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. §§ 2131 et seq.) (AWA or Act), by a complaint filed by the Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, United States Department of Agriculture, alleging that the respondent violated the Regulations and Standards issued pursuant to the Act (9 C.F.R. § 1.1 et seq.) (Regulations and Standards). This decision is entered pursuant to the consent decision provisions of the Rules of Practice applicable to this proceeding (7 C.F.R. § 1.138).

Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations in the complaint and specifically admits that the Secretary has jurisdiction in this matter, neither admits nor denies the remaining allegations, waives oral hearing and further procedure, and consents and agrees, for the purpose of settling this proceeding, to the entry of this decision. Complainant agrees to the entry of this decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Respondent Wilma Jinson is an individual whose business mailing address is 1161 Beaver Road, Stella, Missouri 64867. At all times mentioned in the complaint, respondent was a dealer (breeder) as that term is defined in the Act and the Regulations, and held AWA license number 43-A-2656.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent having admitted the findings of fact set forth above, and the parties having agreed to the entry of this decision, such decision will be entered.

ORDER

1. Respondent, her agents and employees, successor and assigns, directly or through any corporate or other device, shall cease and desist from violating the Act and the Regulations and Standards issued thereunder.

2. Animal Welfare Act license number 43-A-2656 is revoked, effective September 1, 2016.

The provisions of this order shall become effective immediately. Copies of this decision shall be served upon the parties.
