## FACTS AND FIGURES

- States with Projects: California, Washington, Colorado, New Mexico, Michigan, Illinois
- Number of Restoration Projects in this Partnership: 13
- 6 National Forests and 1 National Tallgrass Prairie improved
- About 1,200 Acres of Land Restored (770 acres-wetland restoration and 437 acres-invasives removal), including nearly 17,000 feet of drain tile removed to support wetland restoration
- 10 Miles of streams restored
- 1200 native trees/shrubs planted
