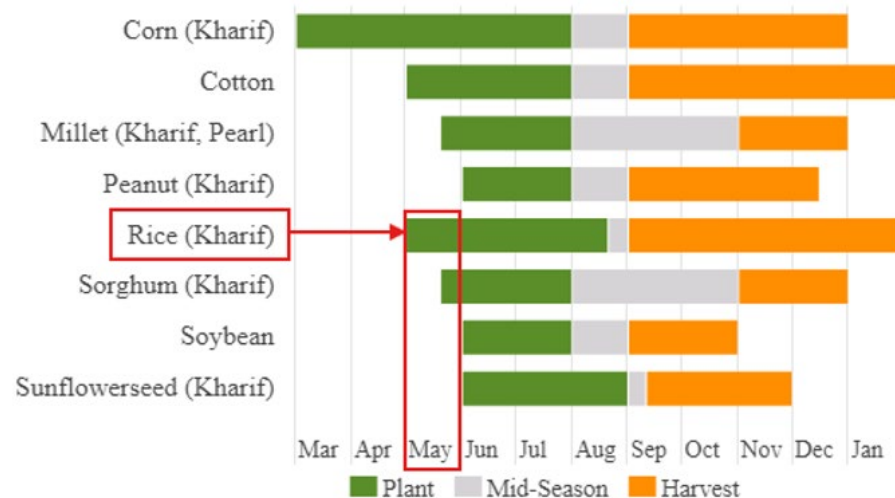

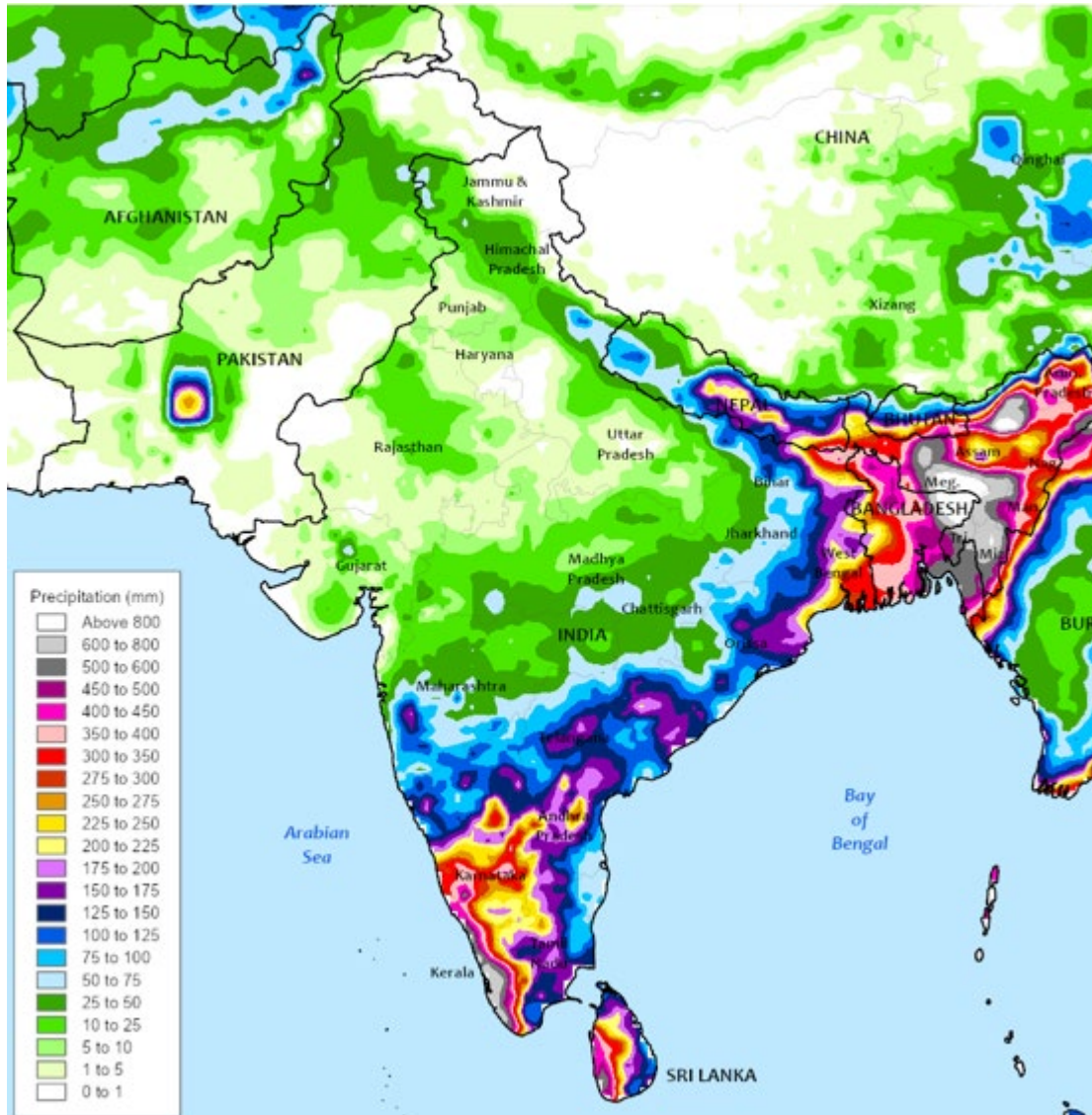

Total Precipitation May 1 – June 4, 2024

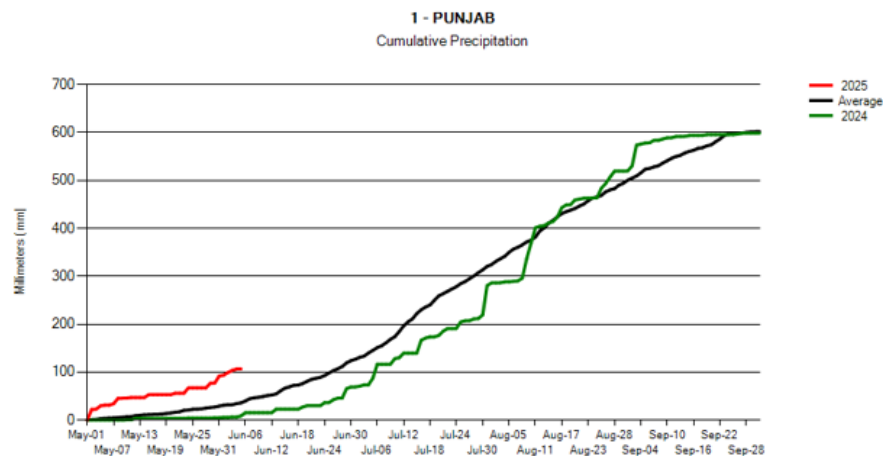
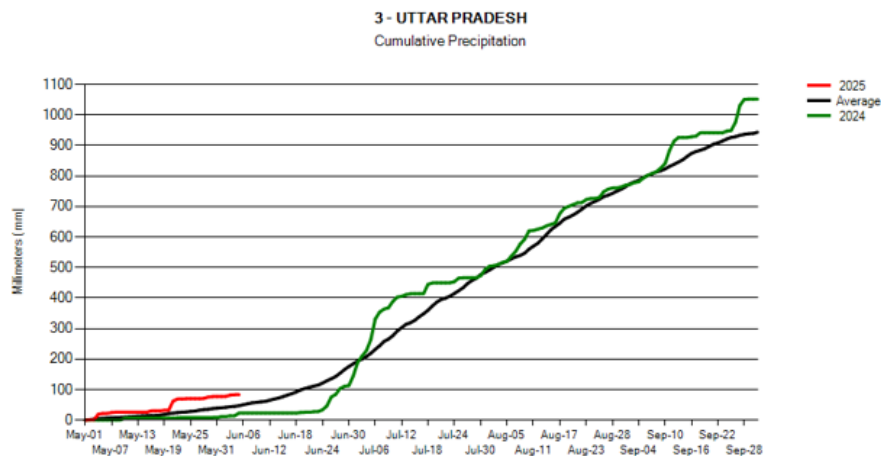
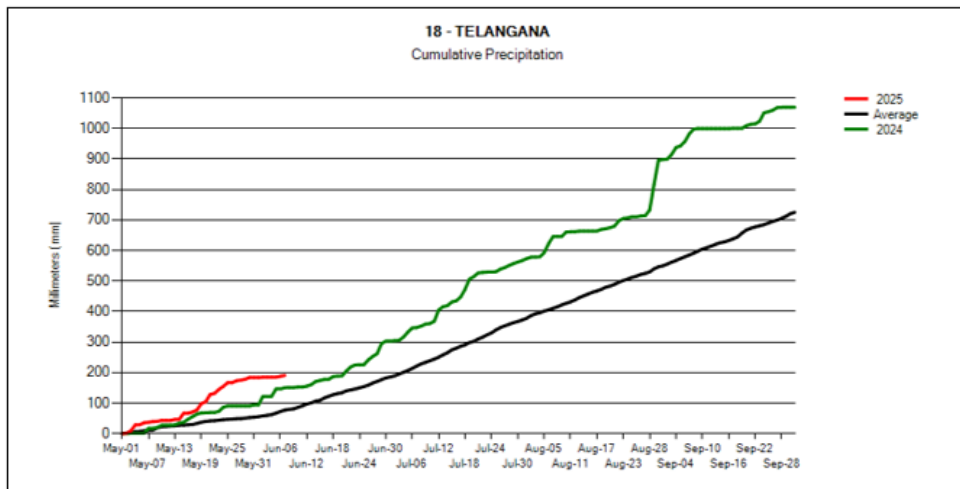


Total Precipitation May 1 – June 4, 2025



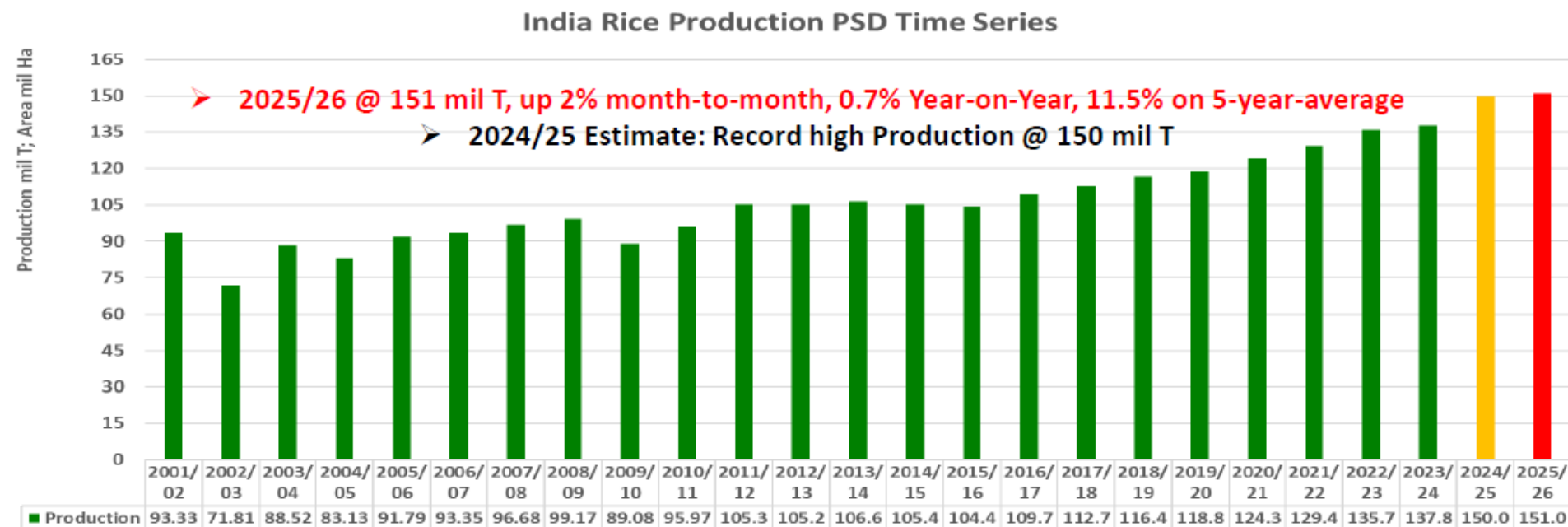


Precipitation in India's top 3 rice producing areas
