Dr. Lysa Porth is an Assistant Professor and Guy Carpenter Research Chair in Agricultural Risk Management and Insurance, and Director of the Warren Centre for Actuarial Studies and Research, I.H. Asper School of Business, University of Manitoba. Lysa also holds a cross appointment in the Department of Agribusiness and Agricultural Economics at the University of Manitoba, and Adjunct Professor in the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science at the University of Waterloo.
