Drought Tendency During the Valid Period *Released November 17, 2016*






Depicts large-scale trends based on subjectively derived probabilities guided by short- and long-range statistical and dynamical forecasts. Use caution for applications that can be affected by short lived events. "Ongoing" drought areas are based on the U.S. Drought Monitor areas (intensities of D1 to D4).

NOTE: The tan areas imply at least a 1-category improvement in the Drought Monitor intensity levels by the end of the period, although drought will remain. The green areas imply drought removal by the end of the period (D0 or none).








- **Overall Moisture Graph**

[6184] NC-JRH Grain Farms LLC No Cover Crop




- **Overall Moisture Graph**

Soil Temp: NC-JRH Grain Farms LLC-with Cover Crop




- **Temperature Graph**

- Daily fluctuation of 4" sensor less after June-27 due to denser corn crop shading soil

- **Temperature Graph**
- Slightly warmer soil temperatures
- Daily fluctuation of 4" sensor more after June-27 due to less dense corn crop shading soil




