






Composition of U.S. Ag Exports to China



United States Share of China Ag Imports




2020 China Imports from U.S. vs Top Competitors



China Phase One Agreement: Key Technical Measures

- Poultry meat: ban lifted and regionalization protocol signed
- Beef: MRLs established for synthetic hormones, 30-month age limit removed
- Pet Food: restrictions on poultry and beef content lifted
- Rice: import protocol finalized
- Meat, dairy and feed ingredient: facility and product registration expedited
- Phytosanitary restrictions lifted: nectarines, blueberries, avocados, barley, hay, almond meal, and chipping potatoes
- Expanded species list of seafood eligible to export to China
- Biotech
- WTO litigation on grains (TRQs and subsidies)



- Tight global supplies for all major oilseeds are boosting prices







Oilseeds: China Soybean Import Shares

Cumulative Monthly Oilseeds Exports to China













Oilseeds: Soybean Prices



- Rice up on higher unit values due to strong domestic demand






Monthly U.S. Corn Exports to China




China Corn Prices




Cereals: Monthly U.S. Sorghum Exports to China







Monthly U.S. Wheat Exports to China




China Wheat Prices

China Domestic and Imported Wheat Prices





Cumulative Monthly Meat Exports to China


Monthly U.S. Pork Exports to China










Monthly U.S. Poultry Exports to China




Cumulative Monthly Cotton Exports to China




Cumulative Monthly Seafood Exports to China



Cumulative Monthly Other Ag Exports to China






Monthly U.S. Tree Nut Exports to China







Monthly U.S. Horticulture (ex. Tree Nuts) Exports to China





China Phase One Agreement: Looking Forward

- China Export Forecast for Fiscal Year 2021: \$31.5 Billion
- Outstanding Sales for Marketing Year 2020/21 & 2021/22 as of February 4:
 - Corn: 11.2 MMT
 - Soybeans: 4.3 MMT
 - Sorghum: 2.6 MMT
