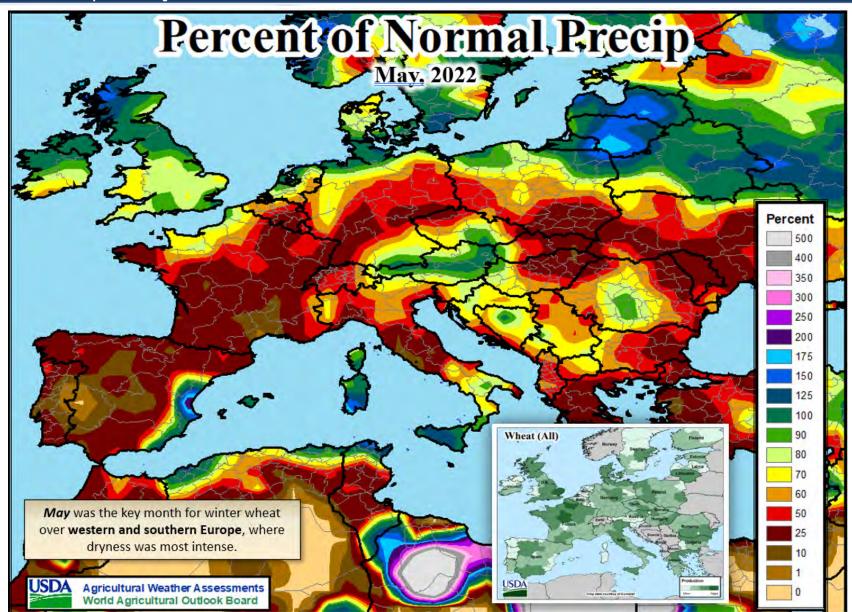
#### Highlights

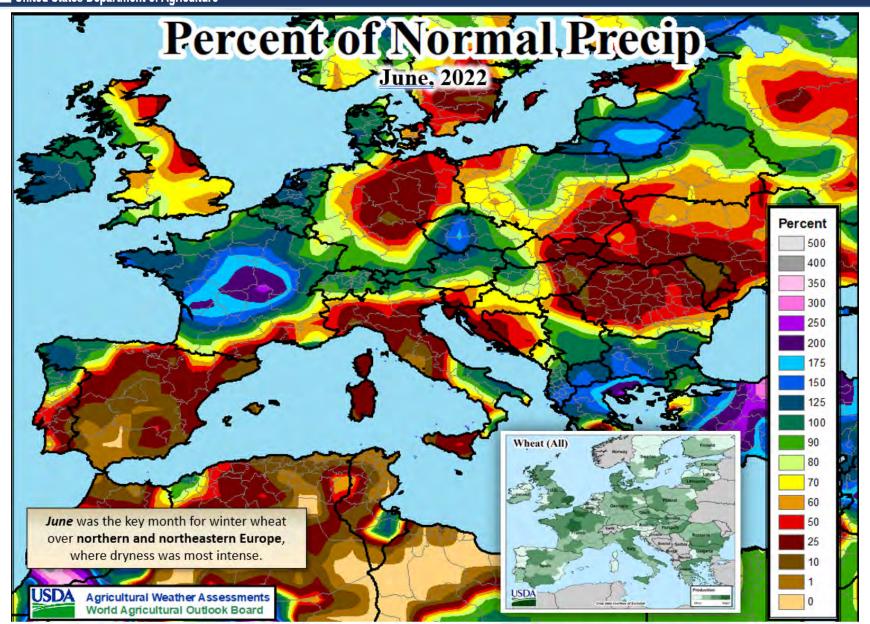
- Drought conditions persist in major production regions of the European Union. EU wheat production is reduced 2.0 million tons and rice production is lowered 16 percent.
- Ukraine wheat production is lowered 10 percent based on updated government acreage data (production is down 41 percent from the previous year). Ukraine's harvest is underway.
- U.S. balance sheets are updated with June *Acreage* report and *Grain Stocks* report data; wheat balance sheet includes new NASS production forecasts.

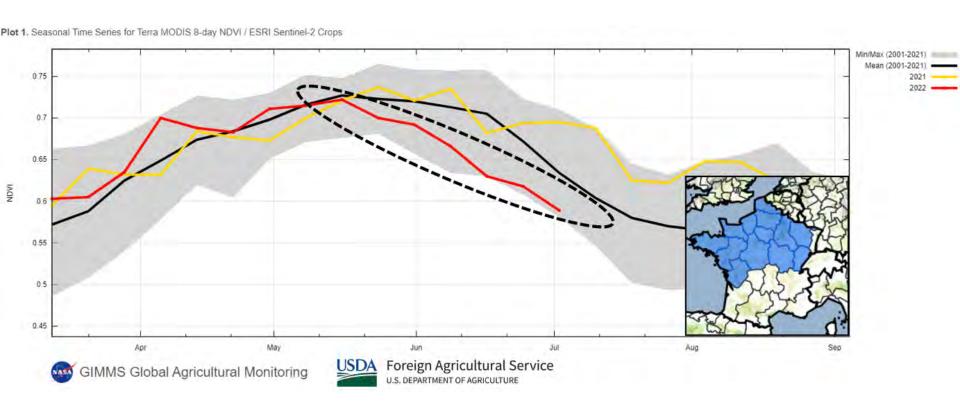

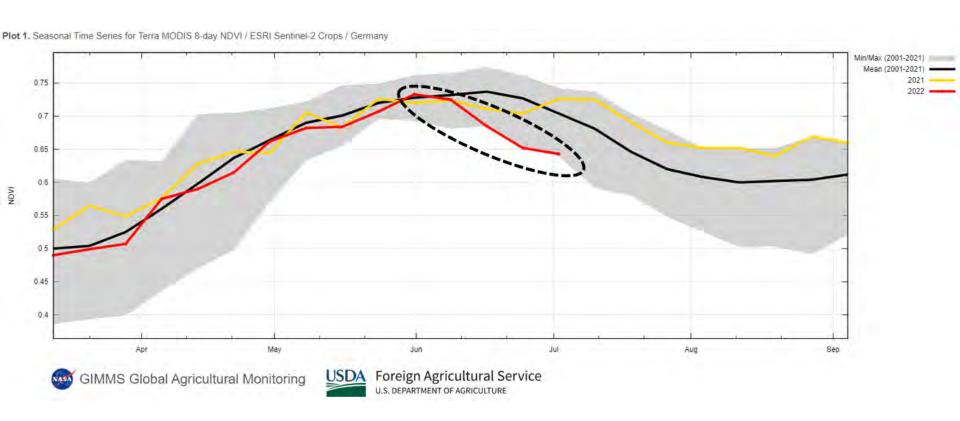




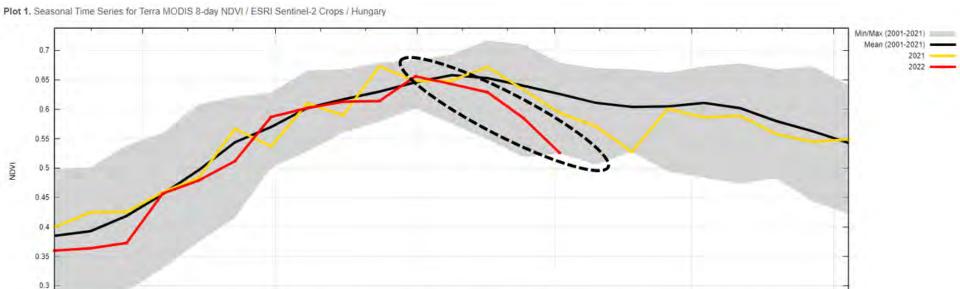
#### **France NDVI Time Series**

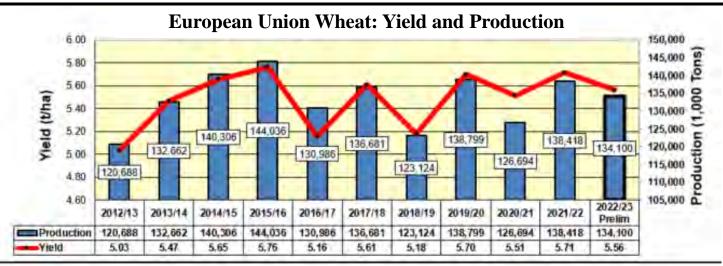

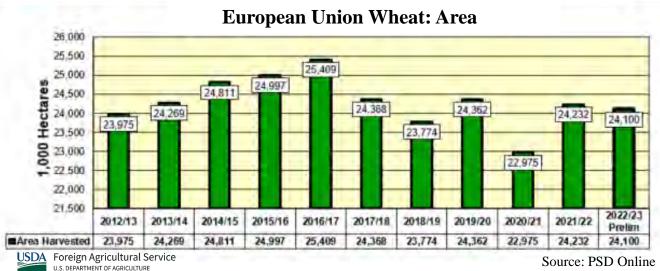

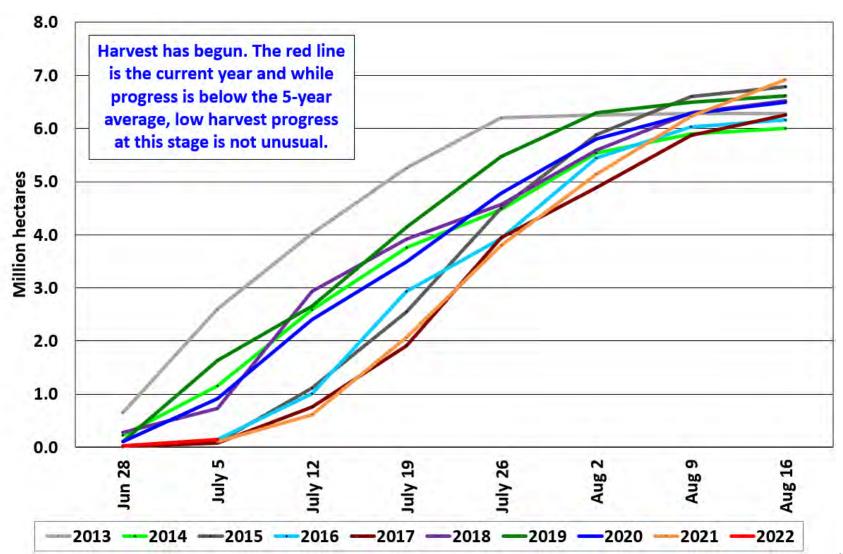




#### **Ukraine Winter Wheat Area Overlaid with Conflict**

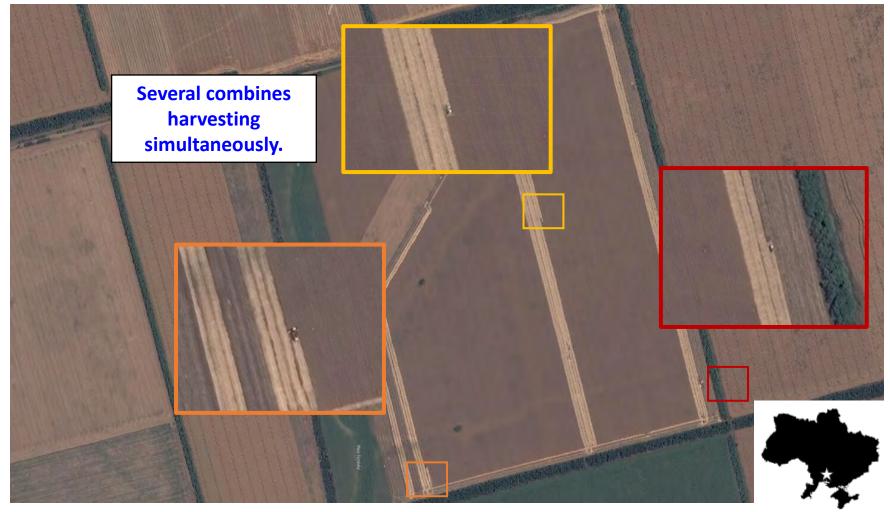


#### **Ukraine Wheat Harvest (Area)**





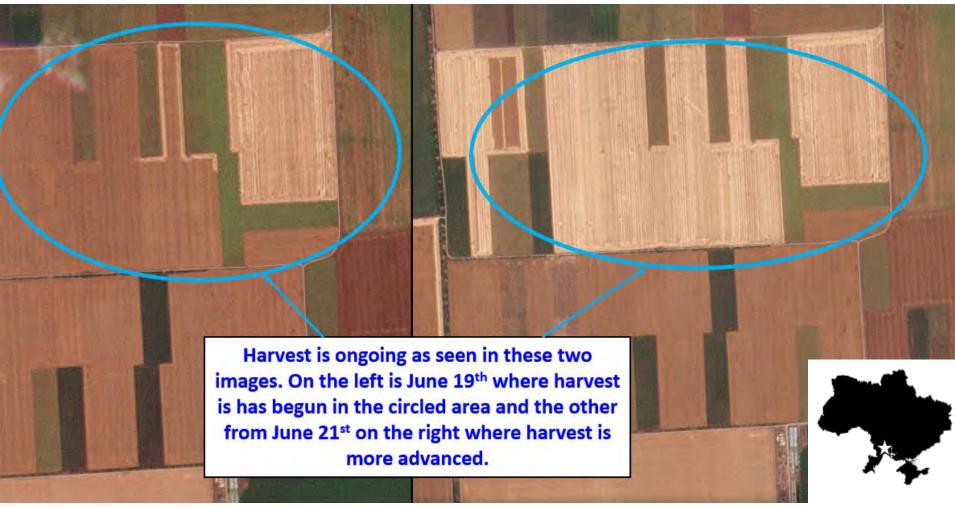

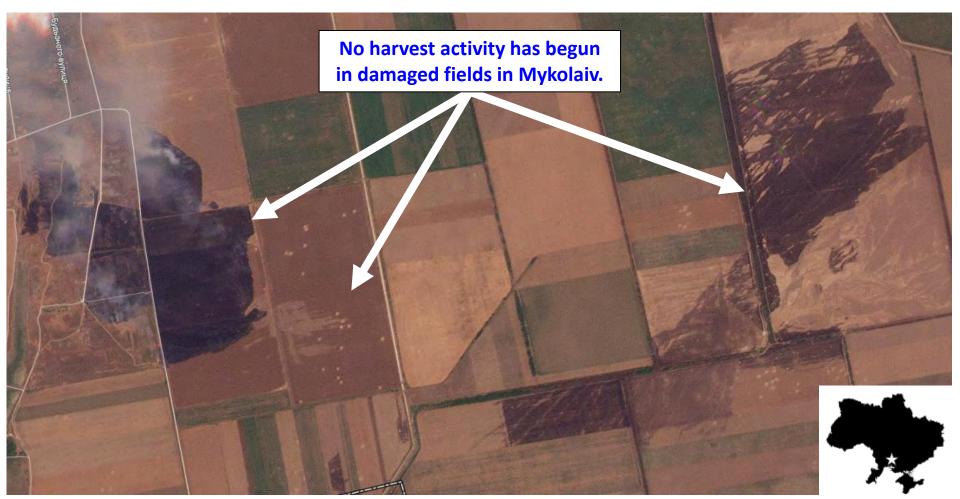


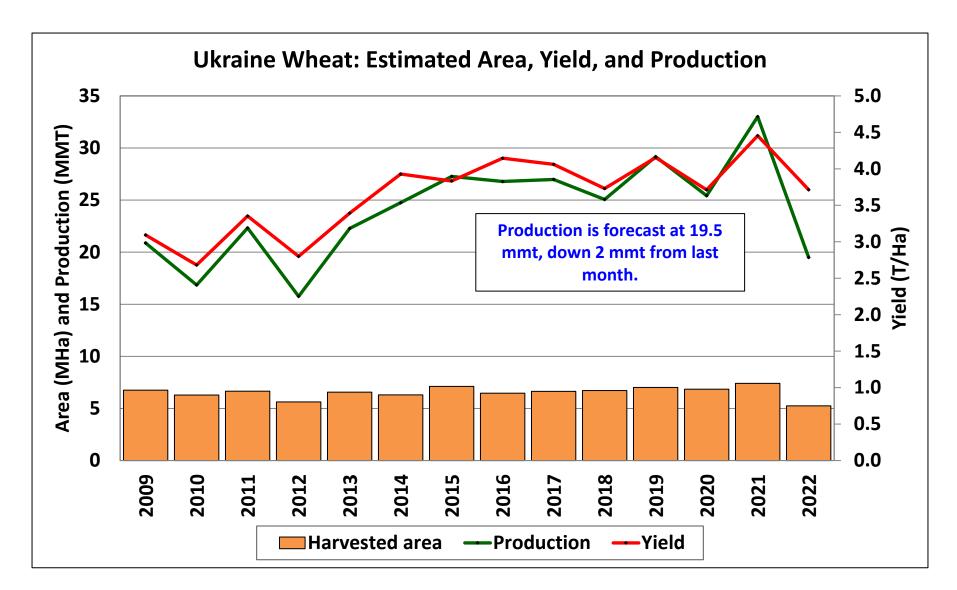

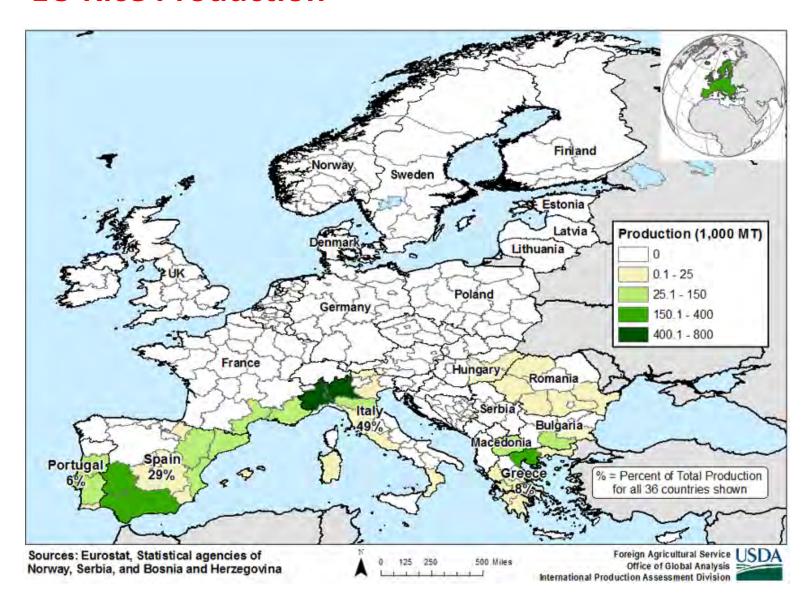

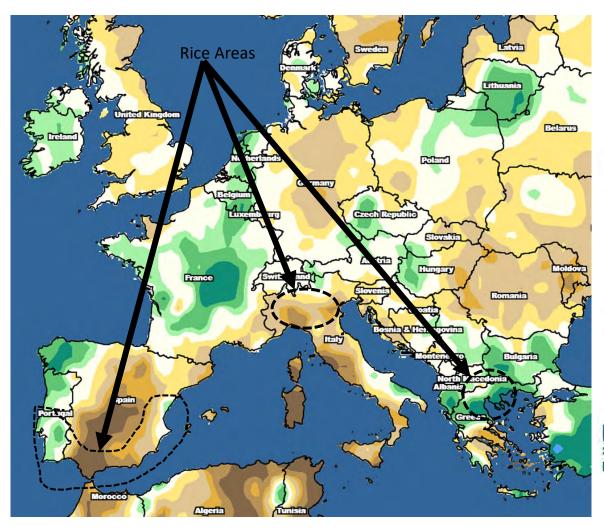

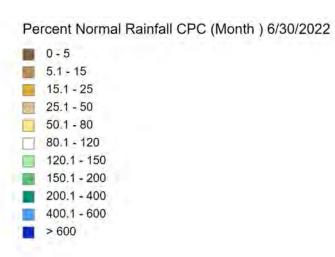

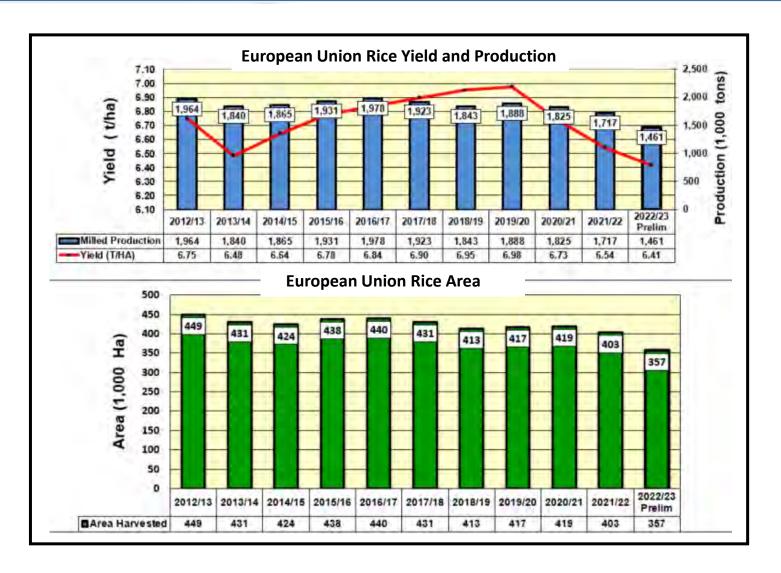

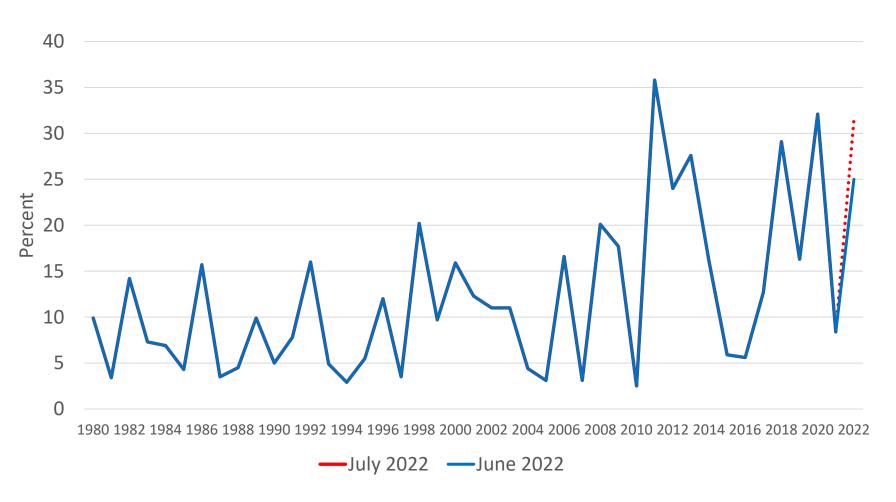
