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Tips for Using the System Overview

- The online application system is web-based
- The best browsers to use include the following:
 - Google Chrome
 - Microsoft Edge
 - Mozilla Firefox
- The applicant should click the “Save” button whenever visible, and often while working in detailed sections of the application
- The system will log an applicant out after 10 minutes of inactivity
- Changes an applicant makes in one section of the application flow throughout the rest of the application
- Applicants may consult the application guide for detailed instructions on every section

Access Credentials and Account Set-Up

- Previous applicants may use an existing account
- If an applicant is new to ReConnect they will:
 - Get a Level II eAuthentication (e-Auth) credential
 - Obtain it at <https://www.eauth.usda.gov>
 - Every person from an organization who needs access to the application system will need a Level II eAuth
- Submit the Authorized Representative Request (ARR)

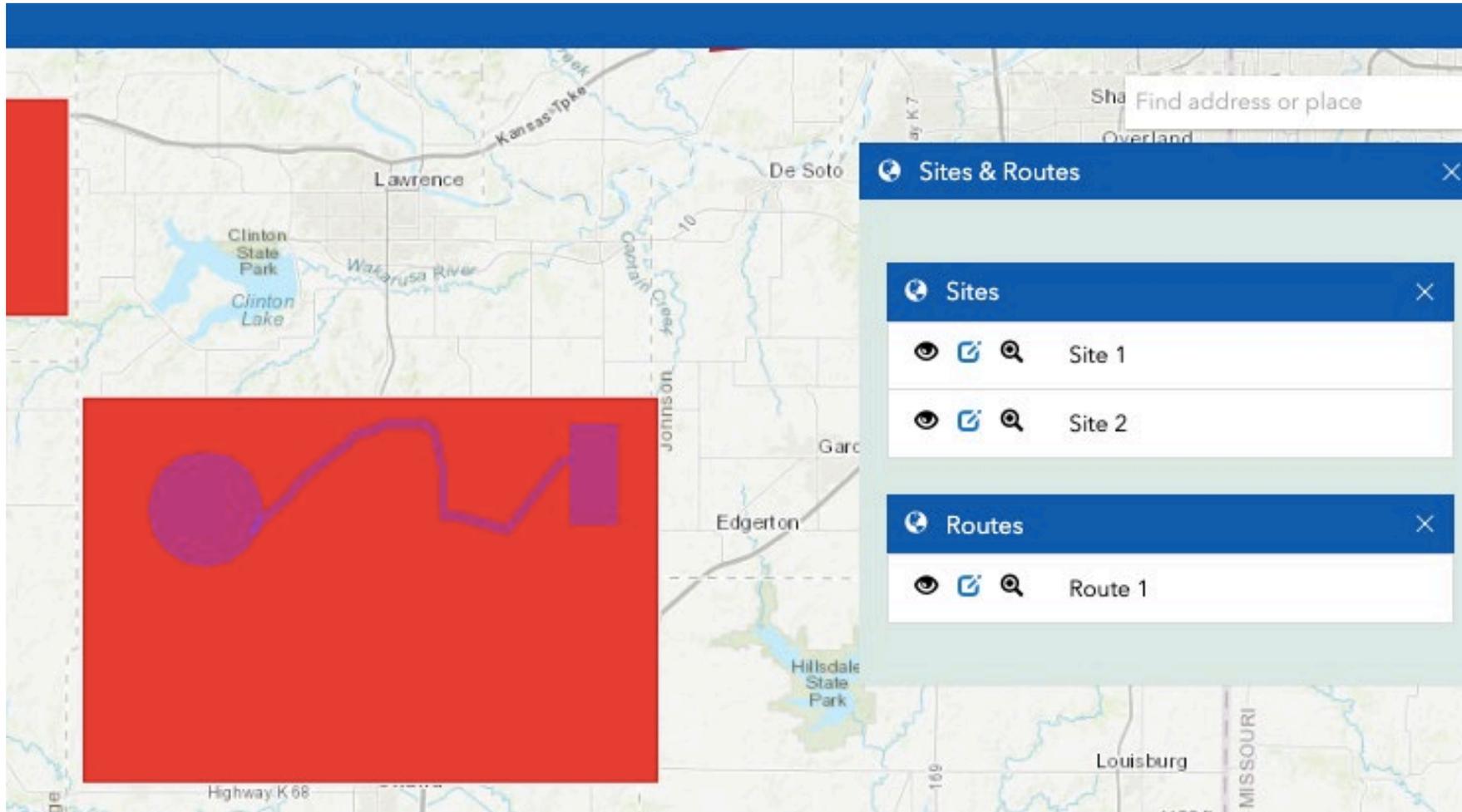
