As local representatives of USDA, Tribal College Liaisons work with Tribes to increase economic development opportunities, workforce development, and Tribal and national food security. Among their duties, they work with faculty and staff at Tribal colleges and universities (TCUs) to identify their priorities and connect them with USDA resources and services. They also advise the broader community, including Tribal nations, communities, and Native American farmers, ranchers, and others on USDA resources and services. Liaisons also recruit students for the USDA Tribal Scholars Program and other USDA internship programs to help build the pipeline of Native American talent at USDA and the agricultural sector. The liaisons are managed by USDA's Office of Tribal Relations Tribal College Program.
