Does Your Store Meet Updated SNAP Stocking Standards? A New Tool Can Help You Check.

SNAP Stocking Standards Calculator

1. Select the foods you stock

Choose the staple food varieties you carry or plan to carry. **Perishable** foods can be fresh, unrefrigerated, refrigerated, or frozen. Tap the icon on any item for a closer look. This list includes some examples, but it does not include all of the foods you could stock to meet the requirements.

USDA Food and Nutrition Administration (FNA) has created a SNAP Stocking Standards Calculator to help retailers check if they meet new stocking requirements.

Starting Nov. 4, 2026, SNAP retailers will be expected to meet the updated staple food stocking standards. The new standards require retailers to stock more healthy foods across four staple food categories: 1) dairy, 2) grains, 3) protein, and 4) vegetables or fruits.

The calculator is an easy-to-use, interactive platform that shows examples of common varieties of food in each of the four staple food categories that retailers can stock to meet the new requirements.
